ACM MULTIMEDIA 2010 Video Program is intended to allow researchers and video producers to demonstrate their research results or video productions without having to bring the equipment for a live demo. Videos should present innovative research results, like for example merging augmented reality and real world entities, showing the use of multiple cameras, camera-arrays or video-sensor networks or communicate complex ideas through novel means and solutions or showing creative applications or multimedia artistic productions in new contexts. The scope of the research presented in the video should be relevant to any of the four major technical tracks; video productions can be of interest of the Interactive Art track.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION

Submissions to the Video Program must include both an abstract paper and a video. The submission procedure is as follows:

- Register and submit your abstract paper via the ACMMM2010 website (Submissions section) before the submission deadline.
- Receive a notice containing the system-assigned ID, the FTP server address and write-only access username and password, just after the submission deadline.
- Submit your video to the FTP server address through the FTP service within 48 hours after receiving the notice, using the assigned ID as file name. The FTP service will be opened starting from April 30, 2010.
- Receive a confirmation e-mail after the video has been checked.

Papers of the Video Program must be in the same format as Short papers (<http://www.acmmm10.org/authors/submission/full-and-short-papers/>).

The maximum length allowed for Video papers is 4 pages.

Videos should be in a standard archival format such as MOV, MPEG2 and H.264.

The allowed duration is in between 3 and 8 minutes.

The minimum quality allowed is 320*240 pixels spatial resolution and 15fps.

Paper and Video contributions are reviewed together. The display of the videos at the Conference will be prepared by the Video Program Committee. The principal author is required to give a short introduction to his/her work.

Papers and videos accepted will be included in the ACM Digital Library.
